 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned  
 having complied with all the Requirements of Chap 6  
 of Title 52 of the Revised Statutes of the U.S. & all Local  
 Ordinances, Laws & Regulations, has located the "Naomie"  
 Mine a Mineral Bearing Lode situated in Sacramento Co. in  
 Creek in South Fork Harris River Mining District and de-  
 scribed as follows. Beginning at the ledge with stakes
