

Notice of Location of Mountain Lumber by F. P. Peniston
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given
 That I, Foreman P. Peniston a Citizen of the United States
 of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied
 with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Third, two of the
 Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws
 thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs,
 laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the twentieth day
 of October A.D. 1896 locate, and by this notice do hereby locate
 a Lode Claim known as the Mountain Lumber Lode or Mining
 Claim, said claim been discovered the Twentieth day of Oct-
 1896, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this head lode
 or vein bearing mineral in place by Four hundred and thirty
 eight feet in width the same being three hundred feet on one
 side of the center thereof, and one hundred & thirty eight feet
 on the other side of lode line together with all dip, spurs and
 angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie
 within said boundaries) situated in Copper Creek Dist. County
 of Skamania State of Washington, said location being described and
 distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent
 monuments and more particularly, described as follows, to-wit:

I do hereby Redescribe location & boundaries of said Claim
 viz 1897. To conform to adverse claims prior located, also
 be necessary to conform to same. The center line is situated
 in the center of copper creek running south about two hundred
 & fifty feet west of the forks of creek and copper stream.
 The east-side line stake is one hundred & thirty eight feet from
 east of center as back line stake, joining the copper stream.
 Thence running south fifteen hundred linear feet to south east
 corner stake, thence running west to center as lode line
 stake one hundred & thirty eight linear feet, thence running west
 three hundred linear feet to south western stake thence running
 north fifteen hundred linear feet to north western stake thence
 running east to lode line stake three hundred linear feet
 and I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance
 with the local customs and rules of miners, and the Mining
 Laws of the United States, and of the State of
 Washington the twentieth day of October 1896
