

Notice of Location of "La Belle" Mine by William B. Dixon
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given
 That William B. Dixon is citizen of the United States of America
 over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the
 requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirtieth of the Revised
 Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws,
 thereof, and of the State of Washington and its local customs,
 laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the twentieth
 day of March A.D. 1897, locate, and by this Notice do hereby
 locate a Lode Mine, known as the La Belle Lode or Mining
 Claim, said claim having been discovered the twentieth day
 of March 1897, and so claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on the
 lead lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by four hundred
 and thirty eight linear feet in width, the same being three
 hundred feet on one side and one thirty eight feet on the other
 side of lode here, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and
 all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within
 said boundaries) situated in Copper Creek Dist. County
 of Skamania State of Washington said location being described
 and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or per-
 manent monuments, and more particularly described as follows
 to-wit:

The La Belle first location on Mountain Lode North end
 of lead line marked by board line, thence to east side line
 one hundred and thirty eight linear feet, to north east
 corner of said line, thence south fifteen hundred linear
 feet to south east corner stake, thence west one hundred
 and thirty eight linear feet, to lode line stake thence west
 three hundred linear feet to south west side East stake.
 thence north fifteen hundred linear feet to North west
 side end stake, thence east to lode line along lode. Three
 hundred linear feet. and I intend to hold and work
 said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules
 of miners and the Mining laws of the United States and
 of the State of Washington.
