Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title thirty two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local laws, laws and regulations, has located 1500 linear feet on the Yellow Lode, situated in Skamania Mining District Skamania County, State of Washington, and described as follows: -

Commencing at the West end of the Day Top Claim run N 80° West over to Bald Mountain ridge to a point with stone piled around it thence 300 feet to stake and from same point or center of the vein South 300 feet to stake with rock piled around it he takes all veins, lodes and spurs.
