

Notice of Location of Luster Claim by F. M. Luster et al
 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizens
 of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, having
 complied with the requirements of Chapter six of title
 thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and local
 customs laws and regulations, has located 1500 linear feet
 on the Cordoba road Lookout Mountain District; on the fourth
 day of May 1897, locate a Luster Claim of situated in the
 County of Seaman State of Washington and more particularly
 described as follows,

Commencing at a point 500 linear feet westward
 from this point then running 1000 linear feet northward
 thence eastward six hundred linear feet thence southward 500
 linear feet thence to place of beginning. This claim is
 known by the name of the Cordoba located on the bank
 Rock Creek near Lookout Mountain in Seaman County State
 Washington and that we intend to hold and work said above
 described claim as provided by the local laws or regulations,
 and the customs and rules of miners and mining statutes
 and laws of the United States. Dated at Lookout Mountain
 this fourth day of May A.D. 1897
