

Notice of Location of Luster Claim, Lucky Mine by Eastwood and
 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a
 citizens of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years,
 have complied with the requirements of Chapter 6 of Title
 22 of the Revised Statutes of the United States and local customs
 laws and regulations, did on the fourth day of May 1897, locate
 a Luster Claim situate in the County of Kamiah and State of
 Washington and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at this point and running in a westerly
 direction 500 linear ft. thence in an northerly direction 1500 linear
 ft. thence in an Easterly direction 600 linear ft. thence in a
 southerly direction 1500 linear ft. thence in a westerly direction
 500 linear ft. to the place of beginning, said claim to be known
 as The Lucky Find Mine, Located in Lookout Mountain Mining
 District and that we intend to take and work said above
 described claim as provided by the local laws or regulations,
 and the customs and rules of mining and mining statutes
 and the laws of the United States
