

Notice of Location of Big Estelle by E. C. Cole
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given
 That I, E. C. Cole, citizen of the United States of America,
 over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with
 the requirements of Chapter Six of Title thirty-two of the Revised
 Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws
 thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs,
 laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 12th day
 of May AD 1897, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate
 a tract of claim, known as the Big Estelle Lode or Mining claim
 said claim having been first discovered the 15th day of May
 1897, and do claim fifteen hundred feet on this land
 bed or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in
 width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the
 center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles,
 and all others veins or ledges, the top or apex of which lie
 within said boundaries) situated in Copper Creek Dist.
 County of Skamania State of Washington said location being
 first described and distinctly marked by reference to natural
 objects or prominent monuments, and more particularly de-
 scribed as follows, to-wit: This claim joins the claim
 known as the Ida Martin on the South beginning at this point
 and runs 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the south center
 end stake then 300 feet in an easterly direction along the
 claim known as the Tille M to south east corner stake
 then 1000 feet in a northerly direction to north east
 corner stake then 300 feet in a westerly direction along the
 claim known as the Ida Martin to the North center end
 stake then 300 feet in a northerly direction along the Ida
 Martin claim to the north west corner stake then 300
 feet in a southerly direction to south west corner stake then 300
 feet in a easterly direction along the Tille M claim to
 south center end stake. And I intend to hold and work
 said claim in accordance with the local customs and
 rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States
