

Location Notice of A Parcel Lode by M Melchior

To whom it may concern. Notice is hereby given that we Ed Hansen and Ferdinand Powell a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statute of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the Eighth day of May (1897), local, and by this Notice do hereby locate a Lode Claim, known as the St Paul Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the Eighth day of May 1897, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (twenty acres of placer mining ground, situated in Copper Creek County of Kamamaa State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Said Claim is opposite the claim known as Bismark with boundaries on the South on Copper Creek, opposite the Bismark 200 feet then 1500 feet to the Fork, and we intend to toll and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington
