

Notice of Location of Bismark Mine by M Melchior
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby
 given, that I Michael Melchior & Mathias Nichols both
 citizens of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-
 one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter
 Six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statute of the United States
 and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Wash-
 ington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of
 miners, did on the 8th day of May AD 1897, locate, and by
 this notice do hereby locate a Lode Claim, known as the
 Bismark Lode or Mining Claim said claim having been
 discovered the 8th day of May 1897 and do claim fifteen
 hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral
 in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three
 hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with
 all dips, spurs and angle and all other veins or lodes, the
 top or apex of which lie within said boundaries (twenty
 acres of plain mining ground) Situated in Copper
 Creek County of Shumanaid State of Washington said location
 being described and distinctly marked by reference to
 natural objects or permanent monuments, and more par-
 ticularly described as follows, to-wit:

The claim is situated in the Copper Creek Mining
 District on Copper Creek about half mile above Roshet
 creek a tributary to Copper Creek. Center of lode is marked
 with a copy of this notice fastened to an third within 8th
 feet of the Discovery of the Lode, center of claim is 10th
 marked by a 8 to 10 feet fall in Copper Creek which is
 250 feet East of Center line the claim 100 feet East & 300
 feet West up Center line on Copper Creek which is the
 North boundaries of claim then 1500 feet in direct
 southerly line and we intend to hold and work said
 claim in accordance with the local customs and rules
 of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of
