

Location Notice of White Cloud Dis No 1 by W. E. T. Mattick

Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned, in compliance with the requirements of the Mining Act of Congress May 10th, 1872, and the local mining rules of Copper & St. Helens District this day, located and claim fifteen hundred linear feet along the course of this lead lode or vein of mineral bearing quartz, and 300 feet in width on each side of the middle of said lead, lode or vein, situate in the Copper & St. Helens Mining District, County of Kamania, Washington, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
