

Location Notice of Copper Luren Claim by George Norton
 To whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given,
 that George Norton, a Citizen of the United States of America
 conforming to the mining Laws thereof and of the State of
 Washington and the local regulations and customs of miners
 has located and by this Notice do-locate claim known as the
 Copper Luren Lode or Mining claim said claim being dis-
 covered the 19th day of June 1897 and do claim fifteen (1500)
 hundred linear feet on the head, lead or vein bearing mineral
 in place, six (600) hundred feet in width, the same being
 three (300) hundred feet on each side of the center thereof,
 together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins
 or lodes the top or apex of which the southern and bound-
 aries, situated in Cold Mountain Mining District County
 of Skamania State of Washington, said location being described
 and marked on the ground as follows, to wit:

Commencing at this stake and running three hundred
 (300) feet easterly, to corner stake, thence fifteen hundred
 (1500) feet in a southerly direction to stake, thence six hun-
 dred (600) feet westerly to stake, thence northerly fifteen hundred
 (1500) feet to stake thence easterly three hundred (300) feet to
 place of beginning, the same being an extension of the Exeter
 mine situated on Star Jacked Creek a tributary of the Washington
 mine owned by
