

Notice of Location of Lode Claim "Big Sadie" by A D Wright
 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States over the age of twenty-one years, on the 10 day of June 1897, discovered a vein or lode of Lode or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and hereon this 10 day of June 1897, under and in accordance with the Revised Statute of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District Mining District, County of Shumanwa and State of Wash, region of Rusler, lode and known as the Big Sadie Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from the notice at the discovery or prospect-shaft: the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by surface to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

750 Seven hundred & fifty feet East & Seven hundred & fifty feet North West from prospect hole and 200 three hundred feet on each side from center North & South and lot on all spurs and dips and angles and all valuable minerals, this claim starting from Bald Mountain trail running 750 feet each way situated on the east fork of the north fork of Washougl river joining the motion claim on the west end that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws, and the customs and rules of miners, and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
