

Notice of Location of Lode Claim. "Katie May" by Robt Whidby &
 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a
 citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty one years,
 on the 15th day of June 1897, discovered a vein or lode of
 Lead or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead within
 the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 8th
 day of June 1897, under and in accordance with the Re-
 vised Statutes of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear
 feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three
 feet and four inches wide on each side of the center of said
 lode situated in the Texas Lode Mining District, County of
 Okanogan and State of Washington and known as the Katie
 May Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to
 and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft: the
 exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked
 by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments,
 and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at point of Discovery on west boundary
 of the M. D. Bella Mining Claim, running 1500 feet from
 location stake in a Northwesterly direction & 200 ft on each
 side of center of claim ledge is situated on Texas Lode
 about 2 miles from head of same. And that they
 intend to hold and work said above described claim as
 provided by the local laws, and the customs and rules of
 miners, and mining statutes and laws of the United States
