

Notice of Vacation of Addenda Claim by Douglas Caples
 Notice is hereby that the undersigned, a Citizen of
 the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, and this
 day located under the laws of the United States, and the State
 of Washington, a Quartz Mining Claim, described as follows,
 the wit: Beginning at the East center end
 stake of the Blue Bird claim and running thence in a Northerly
 direction, 200 feet to North East corner; thence 1500 feet Easterly
