

Notice of Location. Orelia mine by C. Cole

To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given, That C. Cole, Citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty, Book of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 23rd day of June AD 1897, locate, and by this Notice do hereby locate a lode claim known as the Orelia Lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 23rd day of June 1897, and do claim fifteen hundred and linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries (twenty acres of placer mining ground), situated in Copper Creek Mining District, County of Garman, State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects and permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point in the center of Copper Creek 300 feet East of the South East corner of the Henry claim. It runs 1200 feet more or less in a southerly direction to the North End of the Bulger claim Thence West by 300 feet along the line of the Bulger to the East line of the Ellen Mine claim Thence North by along the Ellen claim to center of Copper Creek Thence up the center of Copper Creek 300 feet to the North East corner Stake Thence South by 1300 feet more or less to the North End line of the Bulger claim Thence West by along the North End of the Bulger claim to center end. This is a fractional claim being less than 1500 feet long but being 600 feet wide the notice and discovery is at North corner. And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington Dated the 23rd day of June 1897.
