

Notice of Location of "Prospect Claim" Addenda No 2" by R.A. Hill and

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a Citizen of the United States over the age of 21 years, on the 6th day of July 1897, discovered a vein of lustrous rock carrying Gold Silver and Copper within the limits of the claim hereby located, and gave the 16th day of July, 1897, under and in accordance with the laws of the United States, located 1500 lines feet of this vein or lode, with surface ground 300 feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the Bald Mountain District, County of Shoshone, Wash, and known as the Addenda No 2, the same being the second extension of the Blue Bird claim or lode, the boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked and blazed throughout their entire length and width and is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point about 1800 feet below the Blue Bird trail above head of silver creek at a stake joining the east end stake of the "Addenda" claim thence running in a Northerly direction 300 feet to N.W. corner stake No 1, thence running 1500 feet in an Easterly direction to N.E. corner stake No 2, thence running 300 feet in a Southerly direction to East center end stake; thence running 300 feet to South West corner stake No 3; thence running 1500 feet in a Westerly direction to N.W. corner stake No 4; thence running 300 feet in a Northerly direction to the West center end stake, or the place of beginning, the said lines being distinctly marked on the ground. That I intend to hold the said claim and work the same according to the laws of the United States and the State of Washington, and the local customs and regulations, as they may be in force at this time.
