

Notice of Location of The Last Hope Lode No 1

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the U.S. and the local customs laws and regulations has located fifteen hundred linear feet on the Last Hope Lode situated in St Helens Mining District State of Washington and described as follows.

Beginning at a stake in center of Lode in Boulder Gulch about 50 feet above first high bluff in said Gulch about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile in a North Westerly direction from the Black falls on Green river also known as the North Fork of the Toutle River thence three hundred linear feet in a Southerly direction to a stake thence fifteen hundred linear feet in a Easterly direction to a stake thence six hundred linear feet in a North by direction to a stake passing at three hundred feet a stake indicating center of Lode thence fifteen hundred linear feet in a Westerly direction to a stake thence three hundred linear feet in a Southerly direction to place of beginning including all dips spurs crooks and angles.
