

Notice of Location of Black Bear

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local laws, customs and regulations has located fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet on the Black Bear Lode, bearing mineral situated on N Side Mt Witt, in the St. Helens Mining District State of Washington, in the County of Skamania, and described as follows: Beginning at a point or place on the center of the lode marked by a fir and running fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a South West direction along the lode to a post and taking 134 feet East and (300) linear feet on the East side of the center of said lode the entire distance of fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet and including said lode with all its angles spurs and dyes. Said Fir Tree being about 200 feet N.E. of point of discovery, thence running N.W. 134 feet, thence S.W. 1500 feet, thence S.E. 134 feet, thence N.E. 1500 feet, thence N.W. 300 feet to said tree, this is a relocation of the Black Bear and Judy lodes and is bounded on the West by the Red Jacket Mine.
