

Notice of Location of Quartz Claim. I, E. Englehart, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty one years, on the 19th day of July 1897, discovered a vein or lode of Quartz or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 20 day of July 1897, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District, County of Skamania and St. of Wash and known as the Lones Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Begin at Prospect running westerly to West center end Post thence 500 feet Northwesterly to North West corner thence 1500 ft. Easterly, to North East corner Post thence 500 ft. Southerly direction to East center end Post thence 500 ft. same course to South East corner Post thence 1500 ft. Westerly to South West corner Post thence 500 ft. Northwesterly to West center end situated on the Skit-tail creek 150 ft North from the Creek, and that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws, and the customs and rules of miners, and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
