Moody of Dallas City, State of Oregon, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold conveyed and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell, convey and deliver unto to the said G. F. Moody - to his heirs and assigns the following described property to wit: that certain Steam Saw Mill known as the Asher and Brendage Steam Saw Mill located at the mouth of Little White Salmon in the County of Skamania and Territory of Washington together with the machinery Engine, Boilers, Saws, Sawing apparatus with the tools in and belonging to said saw mill and the property of the said Asher and Brendage aforesaid.

To have and to hold the above named and described personal property unto the said G. F. Moody and his heirs and assigns to his and their use and benefit forever.
