

Notice of Location of Lumber Claim 16 to 1 by C. J. Moon  
 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a Citizen of  
 the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the 23 day  
 of August 1896 discovered a vein or lode of quartz in place  
 bearing Gold Silver and Lead, within the limits of the  
 claim hereby located, and have this 23 day of August 1896  
 under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the  
 United States, located fifteen hundred feet of this vein or  
 lode in length with surface ground, three hundred feet in  
 width on each side of the center of said lode situated in  
 the Cold Mountain Mining District County of Skamania and State of Wash-  
 ington and known as the Sixteen to one Mining Claim, and extending  
 fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery of  
 prospect shaft: the exterior boundaries of this claim being distin-  
 ctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent mon-  
 uments and more fully and by described as follows, to wit:

This claim is located over a small stream known as gold  
 run the second one on the west side of the Washougal above the  
 mouth of the Blue Bird creek and empties into main fork of the  
 Washougal at the big gorge claim extend from north fifteen  
 hundred feet in a southerly direction and 300 feet on each  
 side of vein, the South eastern corner is located about 6 rods  
 from the main Washougal and north of gold run and the South-  
 eastern corner is south of gold run and about fifteen rods from  
 the Washougal, the North western corner is 300 feet North of Mill  
 and gold run and the South western corner is south of notice  
 and gold run three hundred feet, and said claim is located  
 in Section 13 - Town 3 North, Range 5 East W.M.

And that I intend to hold and work said above described  
 claim as provided by local laws and the customs and rules  
 of miners and mining statutes, and laws of the United States  
 and State of Washington
