

Notice of Location of Lusty Claim.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the "Ninth" day of October, 1875, discovered a vein or lode of quartz or sand rock in place bearing gold, silver and lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 19th day of June, 1877, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States re-located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the Bald Mountain mining district, County of Skamania and State of Washington, and known as the Sophia mining claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice of the discovery or prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

(Beginning at prospect running 300 feet north-easterly to south-east corner thence 1500 ft. north westerly to north-east stake, thence 500 feet same course to north west corner, thence 1500 ft south-easterly to south-west corner, thence 300 ft north easterly to place of beginning.)

This claim is situated about 1/2 mile north of the Blue Bird creek and about 500 feet south-east of a high ledge of rock, and that we intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws, and the customs and usage of miners, and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
