

Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter 12, (6) of title three (3) of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local customs, laws and regulations, has located a Quartz Claim bearing mineral, known as the "Gold Hill" mine or claim, and do claim fifteen hundred (1500) feet, on this lead, lodes or vein, bearing mineral in place, by six hundred (600) ft in width same being three hundred (300) ft on each side of the center thereof together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lies within said boundaries, situated in Gold Mountain mining district, Skamania Co., State of Washington, said location being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the North-west corner end post, which is sixty (60) feet in a Northwesterly direction from the notice and discovering point, and about fifteen hundred (1500) ft. in a Northwesterly direction from the Gold Standard mining claim; also, about seven hundred (700) ft. in a Northwesterly direction from a point on the line between Sec. 17 and Sec. 18, T. 3, N. 6, S. & W. M. about four hundred (400) feet west of the quarter stake, said point on the line being where the center line of this claim crosses, and running three hundred (300) ft. in a North easterly direction to the North-west corner post, thence fifteen hundred (1500) ft in a South easterly direction to the North East corner post, thence three hundred (300) feet in a South westerly direction to the South-east corner end post, thence three hundred (300) ft. in a South westerly direction to the South east corner post, thence fifteen hundred (1500) ft in a North westerly direction to the South west corner post, thence three hundred ft in a North easterly direction to the North-west corner end post, the place of beginning; and we intend to hold and work said claim in accord-
