

Notice of Location of Quartz Claim Gold Hill Mine by [Name] [Name]
 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the 15th day of October, 1897, discovered a vein or lode of Quartz or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver, and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and gave this 15th day of October, 1897, credit and in accordance with the Revised Statute of the United States, located fifty hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode situated in the Lookout Mountain Mining District, County of Skamania and the State of Washington this claim and known as the Gold Hill Mine Mining claim, and extending fifty hundred feet to and from the water at the discovery of prospect shaft - the exterior boundaries of the claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at this stake and notice it runs 750 linear in a North by direction and 750 feet in a South by direction from this stake and notice and 300 feet on each side of the center thereof, situated in the head of Menden Creek to a mile from the Lone Star Mine in Lookout Mountain Mining District in Skamania County State of Washington and that we intend to take and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws and the customs and rules of miners, and mining Statute and laws of the United States.
