

Notice of Location of Carrie Lode by, Caroline Manning
 To whom it may concern. Notice is hereby given
 That Caroline Manning citizen of the United States of America,
 over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the re-
 quirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirtieth, laws of the Re-United States
 of the United States, and of all other mining laws the same, and
 of the State of Washington and the local custom, laws, rules, and
 regulations of miners, did on the 25th day of August A.D. 1897, locate,
 and by this notice do hereby locate a claim, known as the Carrie
 Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the
 25th day of July 1897, and do claim fifteen hundred feet on
 this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred
 feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side
 of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and
 all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said
 boundaries. (Twenty acres of mining ground.) Situated in Canyon Creek
 mining District County of Adams State of Washington said
 location being described and distinctly marked by reference to
 natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly
 described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on Canyon Creek about 500 feet south of
 the junction of Canyon Creek & Charles Creek Stream, 1000 feet in
 a Northwesterly direction to the first line of the Raymond Mine Shance
 200 feet in a Westerly direction to the East line of the Ellwood
 Claim Thence 1000 feet in a Southwesterly direction to the South West
 corner Thence Eastward, 200 feet to the center end stake and North
 Thence Eastward 200 feet to the South East corner stake, thence Northward
 1000 feet or less to the first line of the Raymond Claim Thence along
 the first line of the Raymond Claim to center end stake. This is a
 fractional claim and north end is in a V shape. The discovery is
 in Canyon Creek near North end in old abandoned tunnel on
 Charles Creek at center line. And I intend to hold and work
 said claim in accordance with the local custom, and rule
 of miners, and the Mining Laws of the United States, and of the
