

Notice of Location of Andine Lode by Peter S Moore
 I do hereby give notice that the undersigned, a Citizen
 of the United States over the age of twenty-one years, on the
 24 day of June 1897, discovered a vein or lode of Quartz or
 sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver or lead, within the
 limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 24 day of
 June 1897, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes
 of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet on the vein
 or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width,
 on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the St Helens
 Mining District County of Skamania and State of Wash and known
 as the Andine Lode Mining Claim, and extending fifteen
 hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect
 shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly
 marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments,
 and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a Cedar Tree 6 in through being the discovery
 Point with Notice of Location posted thereon, thence N.W. 500 ft.
 to a larch Tree 18 in thro thence South South 46° East-1500 ft to a
 post 4 in thence N.E. 300 ft to Center Tree 12 in a larch
 thence N.E. to the N.E. Corner a tree Larch 14 in through
 thence N.W. 1500 ft to a Cedar Tree 36 in diameter thence
 S.W. To place of Beginning, Said Beginning Point being
 about 1600 ft N.W. of where Okanogan creek empties into Spirit
 Lake and that he intends to hold and work said above des-
 cribed claim as provided by the local laws, and the cus-
 toms and rules of miners and mining statute and laws of
