

Notice of Location

To Whom it May Concern:

Notice is hereby Given, That the undersigned a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-Two of the Revised Statute of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 11th day of October, A.D., 1897, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the "Elvina" lode or mining claim, said, said claim having been discovered the 7th day of August, 1897, and do claim a fifty hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries; situated in Clapper Creek mining district, County of Skamania, State of Washington, said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
