

Location Notice of Mountain Fairy No 1 by Shully & Kroger

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned in compliance with the requirements of the mining act of Congress May 10th 1872 and the local mining rules of the St Helens Mining District, this day located and claim (1500) fifteen hundred lines feet along the course of the lead lode or vein of mineral bearing luster and (300) 3 hundred feet in width of each side of the middle of said lead lode or vein situated in the St Helens Mining District County of Washington, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at this notice, being the point of the discovery and of claim, and upon which this notice is posted, thence North East 300 feet to a stake, thence North West 1500 ft to a stake, thence South West 300 feet to a post, marked N.W. end center stake being the center of the lead lode and of claim, thence South West 300 ft to a corner post, thence South East 1500 feet to a corner post, thence North East 300 feet to place of beginning. This claim is situated on Florence creek a tributary to the Tuttle River and is about one mile South West of Mt. Summit and the discovery is about 1600 ft. North West of the Mts on a Mt known as the Green range and shall be known as the Mountain Fairy mine No 1.
