

Notice of Amended Location of Lead Claim.
 Little Notice by John S. Copley & Dr. H. M. Lawrence.
 Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned who is a citizen
 of the United States, having complied with the requirements
 of Chapter 115 of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the
 United States and the local customs laws and regulations
 has this day located and claim 1500 linear feet along the
 course of this lead, lode or vein of mineral bearing quartz
 and 300 feet in width on each side of said lead, lode or
 vein, together with all mineral deposits contained therein
 and all timber growing within the limits of said claim
 and all water or water privileges thereon or appurtenant
 thereto, situated in the Cispus mining district of Kammeria
 County State of Washington and more particularly described
 as follows, to wit:

Beginning at Discovery on a terminal
 of the North Fork of the Tangle River and running in
 a northerly direction along the course of the lead, lode or vein
 fifteen hundred linear feet, together with three hundred feet
 in width on each side of the middle of vein.

This claim is located at the foot of a fall or cascade
 and is opposite and joins the "Copley" Lead Claim lode
 claim. The intention of this amended location is to remove
 the North end about three hundred feet easterly to conform
 to the course of the vein and shall be the same as the "Little
 Notice" mine.
