Notice of Location of Gold Mining Claim by Mrs. T. A. Phelps
 Notice of Location, Mountain Beamer, Gold Mining Claim,
 Franconia County, State of Washington.
 I, Mrs. T. A. Phelps, who is a citizen of the United States, hereby
 declare and certify to all persons concerned that she has discovered
 a vein or lode within the limits of the Claim hereby located,
 and we find both a vein or lode of quartz or ore, with
 at least one well defined wall, and that she has filed on the
 day of October A.D. 1894, located and the hereby locate and
 claim, under and by virtue of Chapter Six, Title Thirty-
 two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the
 laws annexed thereto, and the laws of the State of
 Washington, a mining claim upon said lode or vein
 to be hereinafter and named the Mountain Beamer
 Quartz Lode Mining Claim, extending along said
 lode or vein 1500 feet in a N. E. westerly direction, from the
 center of the discovery shaft (at which shaft this notice
 and statement is posted), and 300 feet on each side
 from the middle or center of said lode or vein at the
 surface, comprising in all 1800 feet in length along
 said lode or vein and 600 feet in width, with all the
 rights and privileges as to surface ground and lode
 veins or lodes within the boundaries of said claim and
 otherwise, and the strata, minerals and valuable deposits
 of every kind contained in said veins, lodes or lodes or
 within said boundaries, which are given or allowed by the
 laws of the United States or by the State of Washington.
 The Mining Claim hereby located is situated in about

This location is distinctly marked on the ground so
 that its boundaries can be readily traced by a road or some
 monument. It is at a corner of a shaft where two parties met
 and it is enclosed by a line of 80 feet by 10 feet
 and by substantial monuments of stone at each
 corner of the claim, and the exterior boundaries of the
 claim are marked by small posts or monuments in
 a line with it.

Beginning at a Point 300 feet Eastward
 from the first Monument and location shaft, running
 to the N. E. corner, running thence 1000 feet in a

South West by course to the N. E. Corner, thence in North
Easterly direction 18 or 19 ft. to the N. E. Corner, thence Easterly
600 feet to N. E. Corner or first of beginning.
