

Notice of Location of Eva No 5 Mine by E. H. Long, Roy Sibley  
 and N. B. Rankin

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned are citizens of the United States and over the age of twenty one years.

Having complied with Chapter six of title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and local laws and customs of the State of Washington.

Have this thirty first day of July 1897 located fifteen hundred linear feet along the mineral bearing lode, ledge or deposit, by three hundred feet on each side of center of said ledge with all its dips spurs and angles, containing gold, silver, copper iron or tin or any other precious metals that may be discovered within said boundaries of said claim and known as the Eva No 5 mine and described as follows:

Said claim is situated on a tributary of the Lewis River and in Skamania County State of Washington about six miles in a north westerly direction from Mt Adams, joining the Eva No 1 on the west and the Shepherd on the south and the boundary lines commencing at this discovery stake and running easterly three hundred feet to the east and center stake, thence three hundred feet northerly to the south east corner stake, thence fifteen hundred feet westerly to the north west corner stake, thence three hundred feet south westerly to the west and center stake, thence three hundred feet southerly to the south west corner stake, thence fifteen hundred feet easterly to the south east corner stake, thence three hundred feet westerly to the east and center stake, thence three hundred feet westerly to discovery or place of beginning.
