

Location Notice of Quartz Lode Epwa Mine No 2 by E. H. Lacey
Ray Hilkey and A. B. Rankin

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned are citizens
of the United States and are over the age of twenty one.
We are entitled under Chapter six of Title thirty two of the
Revised Statutes of the United States and the local laws and
Customs of the State of Washington.

Have this thirty first day of July 1897 located fifteen
hundred linear feet along the mineral bearing lode,
ledge or deposit by three hundred feet on each side of
center of said ledge with all its dips, spurs, veins, angles
containing gold, silver, copper, iron or tin or any other
precious metals that may be discovered within said bounda-
ries of said claim, known as the Epwa mine No 2 and
described as follows:

Said claim is situated on a tributary
of the Lewis River and in Skamania County six
miles in a north westerly direction from Mt Adams
joining the Epwa No 1 on the north and the Epwa No 3
on the east and the boundaries lines come in bearing
at this discovery stake and running northerly three
hundred feet to the north west corner stake thence easterly
fifteen hundred feet to the north east corner stake thence
three hundred feet southerly to the east end center
stake thence three hundred feet southerly to the south east
corner stake thence fifteen hundred feet southerly to the
west end center stake or the place of beginning.
