

A certain Notice of Quartz Claim "Quartz" by Ed Long
Roy Sibley and A. B. McKinnis.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned are citizens of the United States and over the age of twenty-one years.

Having complied with Chapter six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local customs and laws of the State of Washington.

Have this thirtieth day of July 1897 located fifteen hundred feet along this mineral bearing lode, ledge or deposit by three hundred feet on each side of the center of said ledge, with all its dips, spurs and angles containing gold, silver, copper, iron or tin or any other precious metals that may be discovered within the boundaries of said claim known as the Eva No 1 and described as follows:

Said claim is situated on a triline land of the Lewis River in Skamania County six miles in a North westerly direction from Mt Adams and joining the Eva No 2 on the South and the Shepard on the east, and the Eva No 3 on the North, and commencing at the N. W. corner stake and running Northwesterly three hundred feet to the N. E. corner stake, thence fifteen hundred feet easterly to the N. E. corner stake, thence three hundred feet southerly to the east end center stake thence three hundred feet southerly to the south east corner stake, thence fifteen hundred feet westerly to the S. W. corner stake thence three hundred feet Northwesterly to the place of beginning.
