

Notice of Location of Esp. No. 8 mine by E. H. Long
Ray Hilby and R. D. Rankin

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned are citizens
of the United States and over the age of twenty-one years,
having complied with Chapter six of title thirty-two of the
revised statutes of the United States and the local laws and
customs of the State of Washington.

Have this thirty first day of
July 1887 located fifteen hundred linear feet along the mine
and bearing ledge sides or to mark by, have bounded feet on
each side of center of said ledge with all its dips, angles and
angles containing gold, silver, copper, iron or tin or any other
precious metals that may be discovered within said bounda-
ries of said claim and known as the Esp. No. 8 mine
and described as follows:

Said claim is situated
on a tributary of the Lewis River and in Skamania
County State of Washington about six miles in a South west-
erly direction from Ft. Stevens forming the E. corner of
on the west and the Standard on the north and the trans-
-lating line commencing at the corner stake and
running southward three hundred feet to the south
east corner stake thence fifteen hundred feet westerly
to the north west corner stake thence three hundred feet
southward to the west end corner stake thence three hun-
-dred feet southward to the south west corner stake thence
fifteen hundred feet easterly to the south east corner
stake thence three hundred feet northward to the east end
corner stake or the place of beginning.
