

Notice of Location of the Shepard Mining Claim by Ed. Kenny,
 J. J. Kelly, T. D. Rankin and Carl C. Anderson

It is hereby given that the persons designated
 are citizens of the United States and over the age of
 twenty one years.

Having complied with Chapter six of Title
 Thirtieth Two of the revised statutes of the United States and the
 local customs and laws of the State of Washington, Have
 this thirteenth day of July 1897 located fifteen hundred linear
 feet along the mineral bearing lode, ledge or deposit with
 all its dikes spurs and angles containing gold, silver,
 copper, iron or tin, or any other precious metals that may
 be discovered within the boundaries of said Claim
 known as the Shepard Mine and described as follows
 said Claim is situated on a tributary of the Lewis River
 in Skamania County in the State of Washington about
 six miles in a North westerly direction from Mt Adams and
 boundary lines commencing at this discovery stake and
 running three hundred feet in a southerly direction to the
 south east corner stake, thence fifteen hundred feet westerly
 to the south west corner stake, thence three hundred feet
 northerly to the north end center stake thence three hundred
 feet easterly to the north west corner stake, thence fifteen
 hundred feet easterly to the North east corner stake thence
 three hundred feet southerly to the discovery ^{then} place of begin-
 ning
