Notice is hereby given, that E. H. Burghardt, of
 Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon
 a certain lot of fir saw-logs, being about 200,000 feet in
 quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, State of
 Washington, and are marked thus not marked, and are now
 lying in the woods on John Mac'ker's place more particularly

 on bank and in boom on south half of said Henry Shepard
 and wife J. L. C. in said county and state, and said above
 named claimant also claims a lien upon eleven head of

 all of said horses being in possession of Thomas Ryan in Sta-
 mania County, Washington. 5 sets of harness; 1 saddle; 1 black
 smith outfit; 4 bbls skid oil; 2 kegs horse shoes; 6 pair spurs;
 33 1/2 pair coupling dogs; 2 blocks; 125 feet cable; 5 crosscut
 saws; 1 felling saw; 6 wedges; 5 sledges; 18 shovels; 116 feet 1 1/2 inch
 rope; 1 grind stone; 2 pulley blocks; 3 pick axes; 18 grub hoes; 1 foot
 adz; 2 chains; 9 peaveys; 18 axes; 1 box stove; 12 saw handles;
 1 pair skidding tongs; 100 bbls Blacksmith coal; 1 cooking range;
 furniture and utensils, and all other personal property
 said company used in the operation of its business in said
 County and state. All of said property situate in said
 company's logging camp near Stevenson, Washington; also on
 franchise, earnings, contracts and the logging road used in
 the operation of its business; also upon all real estate owned
 by said company in said County and state, said real
 estate being the north half of the S. L. E of Henry Shepard
 and wife as described in book F 272-276 record of mort-
 gages of said County and state, for labor performed upon
 and assistance rendered in manufacturing said logs and
 the construction of said logging road and logging plant of
 said company, that the name of the owner or reputed
 owner is the said J. N. Russell, B. J. Russell, W. J. Smith and
 J. N. Parelius, doing business under the firm name of Russell
 Smith & Co; that Robert Manary former and agent of said Russell
 Smith & Co. employed said E. H. Burghardt to perform such labor
 and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions
 to wit; at the rate of \$2.00 per day for all labor performed,
 except when employed upon the river and for all work perform-
 ed on the river at the rate of \$2.25 per day for all labor perform-
 ed. The said Russell Smith Co. by their foremen and agent
 Robert Manary agreed to pay the said E. H. Burghardt for
 such labor and assistance as hereinbefore set forth; that
 said contract has been faithfully performed and fully com-
 plied with on the part of said E. H. Burghardt who performed
 labor upon and assisted in manufacturing said saw
 logs and in building and operating said log way and
 logging plant for the period of 44 days at \$2.00 per day
 and 17 1/2 days at \$2.25 per day that said labor and assist-
 ance were so performed and rendered upon said logs, and

upon said logging way and upon said logging plant
 between the 1st day of May 1899 and the 25th day of July 1899
 and the rendition of said service was closed on the 25th
 day of July 1899; and 31 days have not elapsed since
 that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for
 said service is \$127³⁸/₁₀₀ that no part thereof has been
 paid except \$94.68 and there is now due and remaining
 unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets
 the sum of \$32.70 in which amount he claims a lien
 upon said logs and upon said personal property
 and said real property hereinbefore described.
 The said E. H. Burghardt also claims a lien on all
 said logs, franchises, earnings, contracts, logging road
 and all personal property and upon all real property
 now owned by said J. W. Russell, B. J. Russell, W. J. Smith
 and J. H. Parelius as partners under the firm name of Russell,
 Smith & Co. in said Skamania County, Washington, to secure
 payment for the work and labor performed as herein
 described.

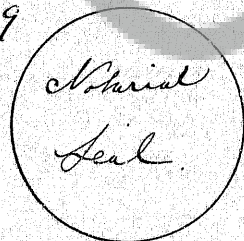
