Notice is hereby given that Wm Moody, of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a certain lot of fir saw logs being about 100,000 feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus "four notches (1111) ground and are now lying in the Columbia river partly surrounded by a boom on the north bank on the Jeff Dix homestead in Skamania County, Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in manu-  
facturing and obtaining said saw logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Russell, Smith & Co. that J. T. Moody one of the partners of Moody and Birby employed said Wm Moody to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

That said J. T. Moody agreed to pay the said Wm Moody for such labor and assistance \$50<sup>00</sup> per month; that said contract

has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Wm Moody, who performed labor upon and assisted in obtaining and securing said saw logs for the period 4-5 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said saw logs between the 25 day of May, 1899, and the 25 of July, 1899; that the rendition of said services closed on the 25 day of July, 1899, and 30 days have not elapsed since their time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$86<sup>62</sup>; that no part thereof has been paid except \$20<sup>00</sup>, and there is now due and remaining unpaid hereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$66<sup>62</sup>, in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw logs. He said Wm Moody also claims a lien on all said boom sticks used in holding said logs for work and labor performed in obtaining and securing said boom sticks, said boom sticks are situated as follows: to wit: on the Jeff Kie claim on the North bank of the Columbia river in Skamania county Washington


