Skamania County Washington for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cutting and making said Shingle bolts; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is J. E. Legor, R. D. Jones or Skamania Lumber Co, that he employed said Chas Keys to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions to wit: That said R. D. Jones agreed to pay the said Chas Keys 80 cents per cord for the cutting and making said bolts; that the contract has been faithfully performed and fully completed with on the part of said Chas Keys; that the labor performed in cutting and making said shingle bolts was rendered between the 1 day of February 1898 and the 31 day Mar 1898; and the rendition of said services was close on the 31 day of March 1898, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said services is \$107.00; that no part thereof has been paid except \$98.08 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of \$11.52 in which to claim a lien upon the said shingle bolts
