

"Salmon River Camp" about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the Columbia river on the East side of White Salmon River all in said Territory of Washington. To have and to hold the same to said Houghton and Palmer and to their heirs and assigns forever.

This bill of sale is intended as a mort-gage to secure said Houghton and Palmer against loss and damage by reason of their endorsement for and becoming surety for the said Dawson and Dent, as follows to Ferry & White of Portland Oregon upon a note for \$1000- and interest due on the 7th day of June 1880. to Remillard of Portland Oregon upon a note for \$ 272⁷⁵ and interest due on the 29th day of May 1880 and upon a bond and undertaking of the Oregon Railway and Navigation Co. on which said Houghton is held as surety in the sum of \$1000 and said Palmer in the sum of \$1250⁰⁰

And if said Dawson and Dent shall pay said notes when due and save the said Houghton and Palmer harmless therefrom and free said bond then these presents shall be void. but if the said Houghton & Palmer or either of them are required to or do pay either of said notes or make any payment thereon or are required to and do make any payment on said bond then they their heirs or personal representatives may at once take possession of all or any of said property above described. and sell the same upon foreclosure suit in the manner prescribed by law. or at their option may sell the same at public auction at the place or places where the same is situate after first giving public notice by publishing the same as provided by the provisions of the laws of said Territory.
