Witnesseth: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars, to him in hand paid to receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confirmed and by these presents, do bargain, sell, alien release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever all that certain piece or parcel of land situated in Skamania County, Washington described as follows to-wit: Beginning at a rock on the North bank of the Columbia River at the south east corner of William M. Murphys Donation Land Claim described in his notification. No. 837. Thence North sixty (60) chains to a stake. Thence west twenty seven (27) chains to Wind River. Thence South to the Columbia River to the place of beginning containing one hundred and sixty (160) acres more or less.
