

This Indenture, made this 25th day of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and Eighty. Between George Miller of Skamania Co. Wash. Ter. of the first part, and Thomas Whalen of the same place of the second part, Witnesseth: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars, to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, aliened, released conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents, do bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that certain piece or parcel of land situated in Skamania County Washington Territory and more particularly described as follows to wit Beginning at a rock on the north bank of the Columbia River at the south east corner of William M. Murphys Donation Land Claim described in his notification No 837. Thence north sixty (60) chains to a stake thence west twenty seven (27) chains to Wind River, thence south to the Columbia River to the place of beginning containing one hundred and sixty (160) acres more or less. Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining: and also, all the estate, right, title and interest, of the said party of the first part, of, in and to the same, To Have And To Hold, the hereinbefore granted, bargained and described premises, with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns to his and their own use, benefit and behoof forever. This Conveyance is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of six Hundred Dollars.
