THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

VANCOUVER 01484. To all to whom these presents shall come, Greetings:

WHEREAS, F.A. HYDE, being the owner of a tract of land situated and included within the limits of a public forest reservation, known and officially designated as the Olympic Forest Reserve, has, under the provisions of the act approved June 4, 1897, entitled "An act making appropriations for sundry civil expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, and for other purposes," reconveyed and relinquished the said tract to the United States and has, under the provisions of said act, selected in lieu thereof the following described tract vacant public land now open to settlement, to-wit:

The north half, the north half of the southeast quarter, and the north half of the Southwest quarter of Section twenty-two in Township eight north Range six east of the Willamette Meridian, Washington, containing four hundred eighty acres:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said F.A. Hyde and to his heirs, the land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said F.A. Hyde and to his heirs and assigns forever. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditched or canals constructed by authority of the United States.
