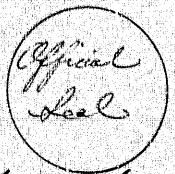

Notice is hereby given that D. Patre claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings and all the real and personal property of Wilson, Gropper & Co., the same being a Company engaged in the operation of a saw-milling lumber and timber business in Skamania County State of Washington, said company being composed of C. Wilson, Casper Gropper and P. J. Bannon, who are engaged in conducting said business, and in the operation of the said saw-milling lumber and timber business under the firm name and style of Wilson Gropper & Co.

That the said property of the said company upon which this claimant claims a lien is as follows, to wit:

Upon a certain wooden building — by — feet in size, situated upon the north east quarter of Section 35, township 3, north of range 7, East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, State of Washington, used as a saw-mill building by the

said company.

Also upon the steam boiler and engine, saw-mill machinery, pulleys, belting, shafts, saws, chains, tools, and any and all machinery or tools connected with or in any manner used in and about the said saw-mill and saw-mill building so situated as aforesaid.

Also upon one wooden flume, running from a connection with a certain ditch leading from said mill at a point in section 1 township 2 North Range 7 E. M. M. in said County, to the Columbia River:- together with the franchise upon which the said flume is constructed and operated.

This lien is claimed for labor performed by the claimant for the said company in the operation of said sawmilling lumber and timber business in Skamania County, State of Washington upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:-

That the claimant was employed to perform said labor and to render said services for the said company by C. Wilson who was at the date of the employment of this claimant to perform said labor and to render said services one of the members of said Co-partnership.

That said company by C. Wilson, one of the members of said company and manager thereof agreed to pay said D. Patre, the sum of \$2⁰⁰ Dollars per day for Twenty and one-half (20½) days, and \$1⁷⁵ for Twenty-four and one-quarter (24¼) days.

Said labor being as follows: 20½ days at \$2⁰⁰ swampy in the woods and general work in the mill and loading ties on the scow. 24¼ days at \$1⁷⁵ per day work on flume.

That claimant commenced to perform said services on the 31st day of August 1899, and ceased the performance thereof on the 27 day of September, 1899 the last services being performed by him for said company the last date mentioned herein, performing between said dates 44¼ days labor for said company, under the terms and conditions as hereinbefore stated.

That there became due the claimant for the performance of said services, in accordance with the terms of said contract the sum of \$83.43 That there has been paid thereon the sum of \$1⁰⁰ and no more. That there is now

and the claimant after deducting all just credits and offsets from the said company, the sum of \$69.43 in which sum the claimant claims a lien upon the property of the said company hereinbefore fully described

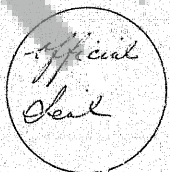
