Whereas, a certifacte of the register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington, has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May, 20th, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Arthur L. Cumming has been established and duly consumated, in conformity to law, for the east half of the Southwest quarter and the South half of the Southeast quarter of Section twenty-three in Township, four North of Easign nine East of the Willamette Meridian, Washington, containing one hundred sixty acres, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the saidland, feturned to the General Land Office by the Durveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That thereis, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said claimant the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of land with the appure tenances thereof, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agriculture manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to divches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or sanals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Woodrow Wilson, President of the United States of America, have caused theses letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
