

Mortgage.
From J. M. G. Kollich.
To

J. N. Fisher.

This Indenture made the 14th day of February A.D. 1881. between J. M. G. Kollich. party of the first part; and J. N. Fisher party of the second part. Witnesseth. That the party of the first part; for, and consideration of Five Hundred Dollars, Gold Coin, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has bargained, and sold, and does hereby convey unto the party of the second part, the following described real property, situated in the County of Skamania, and Territory of Washington. To wit: One Acre of Land, where the Ice House of the party of the first part is located, and upon which it is situate on Battle Rock Slough, two miles from Lower Cascades, in said County, and Territory, together with the Ice House buildings and improvements on said lands.

He have and to hold the said premises, and appurtenances to the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever. And the party of the first part, covenants that he is the owner of a Twenty Five Year in said lands. Nevertheless, this conveyance is intended to be a Mortgage upon the premises described, to secure the payment of a promissory note, held by the party of the second part of which here follows a copy.

On the first day of August next, after date, with out grace, I promise to pay J. N. Fisher, or order Five Hundred Dollars in United States Gold Coin, with interest thereon, from date until paid, in like coin, at the rate of one per cent per month, payable principal and interest
