

Mortgage of Further Assurance
 of
 The Oregon Railway and Navigation Company
 To
 The Farmers Loan and Trust Company;

This Indenture made this first day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty, between the Oregon Railway and Navigation Company, a body corporate, created and existing under and by virtue of the Acts of Legislature of the State of Oregon, in that behalf made and provided, party of the first part, and the Farmers Loan and Trust Company (of New York) party of the second part, witnesseth;

Whereas, the said party of the first part is authorized and empowered in and by its articles of Incorporation, and in and by the several Acts of the Legislature of the said State of Oregon, as follows;

First, - To construct and equip the following railroad and telegraph lines, namely, First. A line along the south side of the Columbia river between Portland and Umatilla. Second. A line from Umatilla across the Blue Mountains through the Grande Ronde Valley in a southeasterly direction to a point on the east State line of Oregon toward Boise City. Third. A line from Umatilla to Wallula in Washington Territory. Fourth. A line from Weston in Washington Territory, southwardly to the point of intersection with the line in Oregon, first described. Fifth. From Walla Walla in Washington Territory, in a northeasterly direction by Dayton, to the Snake river. Sixth. From a point on the Snake river in Washington Territory near the mouth of the Palouse river, along the valley of the Palouse river, in a northeasterly direction to the head waters of the Spokane river. And to maintain and operate such railroads, telegraph lines and branches, carry freight and passengers thereon and receive tolls for same.
