That the amount of Claimants demand for said service is \$61.44 that no part thereof has been paid except \$25.27 and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of \$36.17, on which amount he claims a lien upon said Shingle Mill Machinery and attachments thereto. The said D. J. Jones also claims a lien on all said mill property, machinery and attachments thereto owned by said W. W. Wood of said Skamania County to secure payment for the work and labor performed in making said shingles herein described
