Notice is hereby given that Wm Stephens of Stevenson, Skamania county, State of Washington claims a lien upon a certain lot of saw logs being about 600 cuts in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania county, State of Washington and are marked thus (not attached) and are now lying in the woods on John Washers place more particularly described as follows, to-wit: S. W. 1/4 of S. E. 1/4 and E. 1/2 of S. W. 1/4 and S. W. 1/4 of S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 25 T. 3. N. R. 7 E. of W. 11 in Skamania county, Washington; also upon all logs lying in the boom located in slough upon north half of the Henry Shepard and wife D. L. C., said land being now particularly described in Book F. on page 272-276. record of mortgages of Skamania county, Washington also upon eleven head of horses, branded and described as follows:

To-wit: 1. bay horse branded E on right shoulder, 1 bay horse branded N on left shoulder; 1 grey horse, brand indistinct; 1 bay horse no brand; 1 roan horse branded H on right shoulder; 1 white mare, 1 grey mare; 1 grey horse; 1 white horse; 1 bay horse; 1 brown horse, brand not known, all of said horses being situate in the logging camp of said Philips & Jones on the Henry Shepard and wife D. L. C. in said county and state and in possession of said James Jones; also upon 5 sets of harness; 1 saddle; 1 blacksmith outfit 33 1/2 pr. coupling dogs; 2 blocks; 125 ft. cable; 5 cross cut saws; 1 falling bar; 6 wedges; 5 sledges; 18 shovels and upon all other tools and implements used in said logging camp; all of said above described property being situate in the logging camp operated by said Philips and Jones on the Henry Shepard and wife D. L. C. adjoining the town of Stevenson in Skamania county, Wash.; said Wm Stephens also claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings and on all personal property of said company used in the operation of its business, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in manufacturing said logs; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner, is said Philips and Jones; that said James Jones, one of the partners aforesaid employed said Wm Stephens

to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: - The said James Jones employed said Wm Stevens to work about the barn and about the logging camp and agreed to pay said Wm Stevens for such labor at the going rate, to-wit at the rate of \$1⁰⁰ per day for such labor and assistance rendered. That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Wm Stevens, who performed labor upon and assisted in manufacturing said saw logs for the period of 36 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said saw logs and about said company's logging camp between the 17th day of October, 1899 and the 1st day of December 1899 and the rendition of such service was closed on the 30th day of November, 1899, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$54⁰⁰; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$54⁰⁰, in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw logs and upon said chattels and personal property and upon the franchise, earnings and contracts of said company. The said Wm Stevens also claims a lien upon all property owned by said Philips and Jones and used by them in said Okanania County, Wash. in operating said logging camp to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining and manufacturing and securing the said logs and in working in and about said logging camp, herein described.
