Notice is hereby given that J. Kautz, of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a certain lot of lumber, being about 50,000 feet in quantity, which was cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington; the said lumber being marked thus — and is now lying at the saw mill owned by C. B. Williams, and formerly known as the "Wilson Gopher Co." mill, in Skamania County, Washington, the same being the place where said lumber was manufactured, and situated about two miles northwest of Stevenson, in Sec. 35, Twp. 3. N. R. 7. E. Willamette Meridian in Skamania Co. Washington for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in preparing and securing certain saw logs, out of which said aforementioned lumber was manufactured; that the name of the owner or reputed owners are Hans P. Alrick Jr. and Louis Alrick. That J. Davidson employed said J. Kautz to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: that the said J. Davidson who was at the time of the employment of the said J. Kautz, engaged in logging for Wilson, Gopher Co. off the lands of the said Hans P. Alrick Jr., and Louis Alrick, agreed to pay the said J. Kautz for such labor and assistance the sum of Three (\$3.00) dollars per day; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of J. Kautz, who performed labor upon and assisted in securing and obtaining saw logs, as foreman, out of which the aforementioned lumber was manufactured, for the period of 44 1/2 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said saw logs, out of which the lumber mentioned in this lien was manufactured.

between the 15th day of November, 1899, and the 20th day of November, 1899, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 20th day of November, 1899, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$13⁵⁰; that no part thereof has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$13⁵⁰, in which amount claimant claims a lien upon said aforementioned lumber

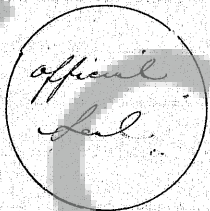
