

C. Dale vs E. B. Williams.

Employee's Lien.

C. Dale,

Notice is hereby given that C. Dale claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings and all the real and personal property of E. B. Williams, who is engaged in the operation of a sawmilling, lumber and timber business in Okanania County, Washington;

That the said property of the said E. B. Williams upon which the claimant herein claims a lien is as follows, to-wit:

Upon a certain wooden building — feet by — feet in size, situated on the North-west quarter of Section thirty-five, Township three North, Range seven East, Willamette Meridian, in Okanania County, Washington, used as a sawmill building by the said E. B. Williams; also upon the steam-boiler and engines, sawmill machinery, pulleys, belting, shafts, saws, chains, tools and any and all machinery or tools connected with or in any manner used in and about the said sawmill building, so situated as aforesaid.

This lien is claimed for work and labor performed by the claimant for the said E. B. Williams in the operation of said sawmilling, lumber and timber business in Okanania County, Washington upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That the claimant was employed to perform said labor and to render said services for the said E. B. Williams by J. Skowbridge, who was at the date of the employment of this claimant, agent and foreman for the said E. B. Williams, in the operation of the said sawmilling lumber and timber business.

That claimant commenced to perform said services on the 26th. day of January, 1900, and ceased the performance thereof on the 24th. day of February, 1900, performing between said dates nine days labor for said E. B. Williams.

That there became due the claimant for the per-

formance of said services in accordance with the terms of said contract, the sum of \$10.00; that no part thereof has been paid, and there still remains due and unpaid thereon the sum of \$10.00, in which amount said claimant claims a lien upon the property of the said C. B. Williams, hereinbefore fully described.

That ninety days have not elapsed since said claimant ceased the performance of said labor.
